Request for Proposal for the Demolition of Redundant Structures at Southern Coastal Mines.

1. Overview

Namdeb Diamond Corporation (Pty) Ltd (Namdeb) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Namdeb Holdings (Pty) Ltd. Namdeb operates diamond mining operations at Southern Coastal Mines near the town of Oranjemund.

Namdeb's rehabilitation plan requires that all redundant steel and concrete structures be demolished and disposed of in an adequate manner before the area (land) is returned to the future land owner in a condition that supports future sustainable use of the land.

2. Specification of the Services

Namdeb hereby invites reputable and qualified bona fide service providers to submit Requests for Proposal (RFP) for the demolition of identified structures at Southern Coastal Mines.

The scope of the services shall without limitation include the safe, legal and proper removal and disposal of asbestos waste; demolition of reinforced steel; demolition of reinforced concrete and proper disposal. Asbestos removal shall be performed as laid out in the approved plan of work with regular inspections by the asbestos Approved Inspection Authority as legally required.

- Practical experience and knowledge.
- Competencies required for the overall provision of the services,
- Appropriate business references.
